

**RESOLUTION
OF THE BSUN GENERAL ASSEMBLY - THE 4TH
CONFERENCE OF THE RECTORS FROM THE BLACK SEA
REGION,
held in Baku, Azerbaijan on September 13, 2002**

1. The General Assembly approved the Report of Activity presented by Professor Suha SEVUK, BSUN President.
2. The General Assembly analyzed the proposal of the new BSUN Statute and, in unanimity, approved it.
